

Water Conservation Starts With YOU

Water conservation in Lomita starts with you – our residents. We would like to remind residents to save water by following the City's Water Conservation and Drought Management Plan, which outlines the following steps residents in the city can take:

- No lawn/landscape watering between 10 a.m. and 8 p.m.
- Timely repair of breaks or leaks (Please note that if your meter indicates you have a water leak, the City will send you a courtesy notification letter.)
- Use of hand-held bucket or similar container to clean sidewalks and parking areas
- Use of hand-held bucket or hose with a quick release shutoff nozzle when cleaning a vehicle
- No excess water runoff from lawn/landscape areas
- Restaurants to provide water to customers only on request
- Motels to provide guests the option of having
- For conveyor style car washes, installation of water recycling system

towels/linens laundered daily
