Project Update: Granular Activated Carbon Filtration System

In March 2021, the City of Lomita held a kickoff event commemorating the start of the project to install a new Granular Activated Carbon (GAC) filtration system at the Cypress Water Production Facility. Initial construction activities began in late February 2021.

The project continues to forge ahead with demolition, surveying, and concrete cutting now complete and excavation for new underground pipes underway. All preparations are being made to bring the project online by Summer 2022.
