- **Adjust Landscape Irrigation**  
Reduce watering schedules as plants need less water in cooler weather.
- **Rain-Related Restrictions**  
Avoid irrigating landscapes during rain or within 48 hours after rainfall.
- **Keep It Clean, Responsibly**  
Do not wash sidewalks or driveways with water to remove leaves or mud after rain.

To help maintain water quality, the City will flush fire hydrants, particularly at dead-end lines. While we are committed to conservation, these flushes are necessary to keep your drinking water clean and safe.
