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Emergencies can happen anytime —stay ready by signing up for Alert SouthBay.

Alert SouthBay is a regional notification system designed to provide updates during critical incidents. You must sign up and opt-in to receive Lomita notifications, meaning residents are not automatically enrolled.

Subscriber information will only be used for notification purposes in the event of an emergency. Additional notifications are optional, such as major traffic impacts or emergency preparedness advisories. Alerts will be received via cellphones, landlines, text and email.
